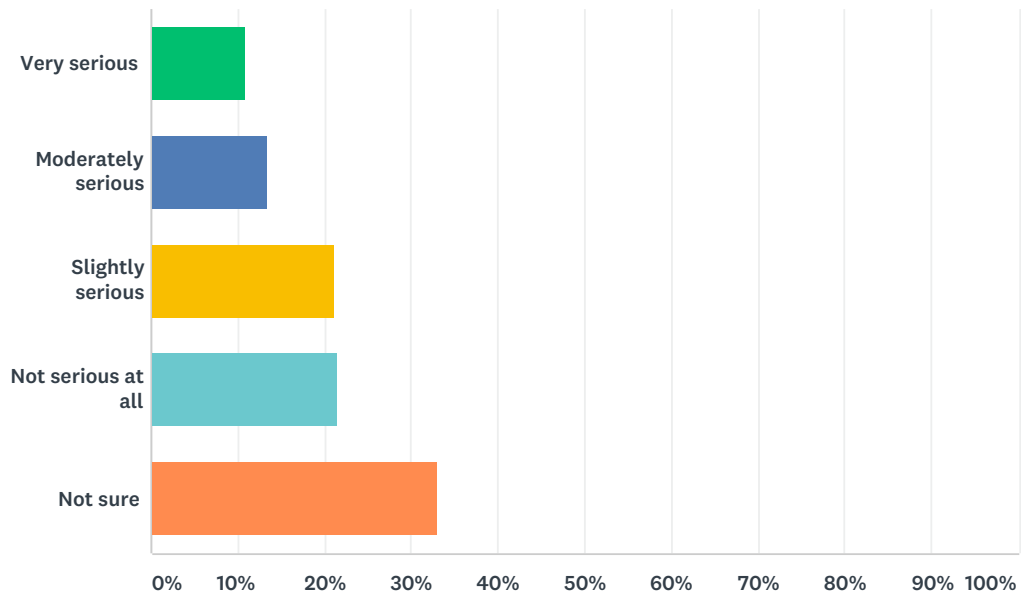


Q1 How serious of a problem is misuse of prescription drugs in your community?

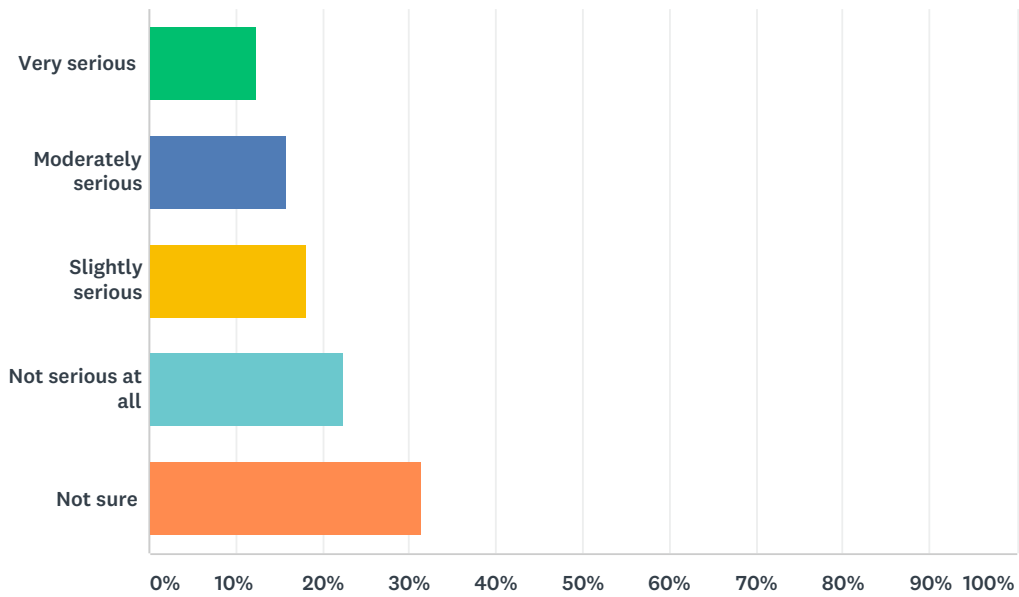

Q2 How serious of a problem is misuse of prescription drugs by youth 18 or younger in your community?

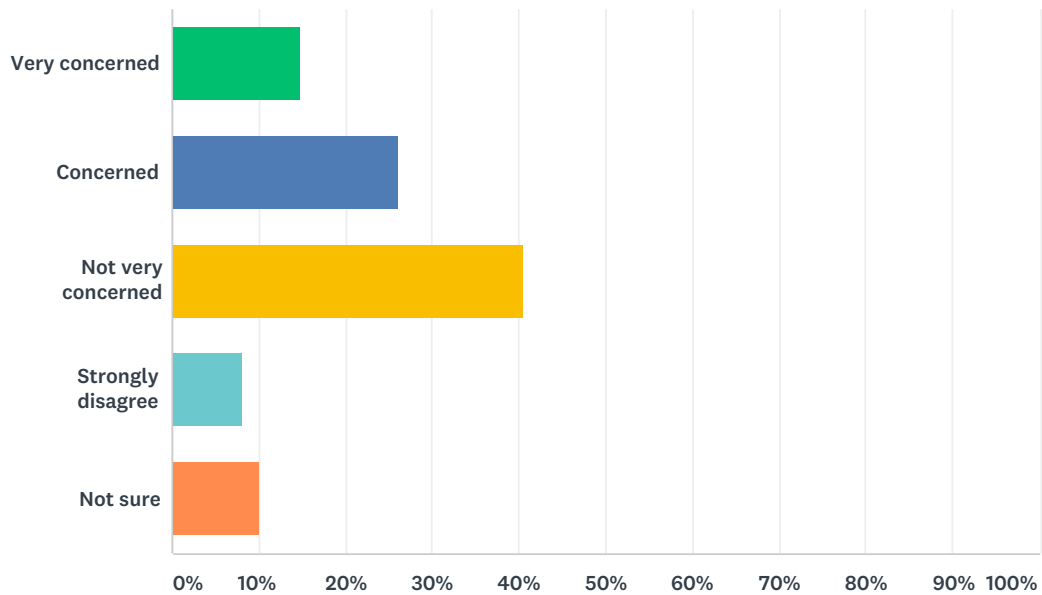

Q3 How concerned are you that misuse of prescription drugs could be, or could become, a growing problem in your community?

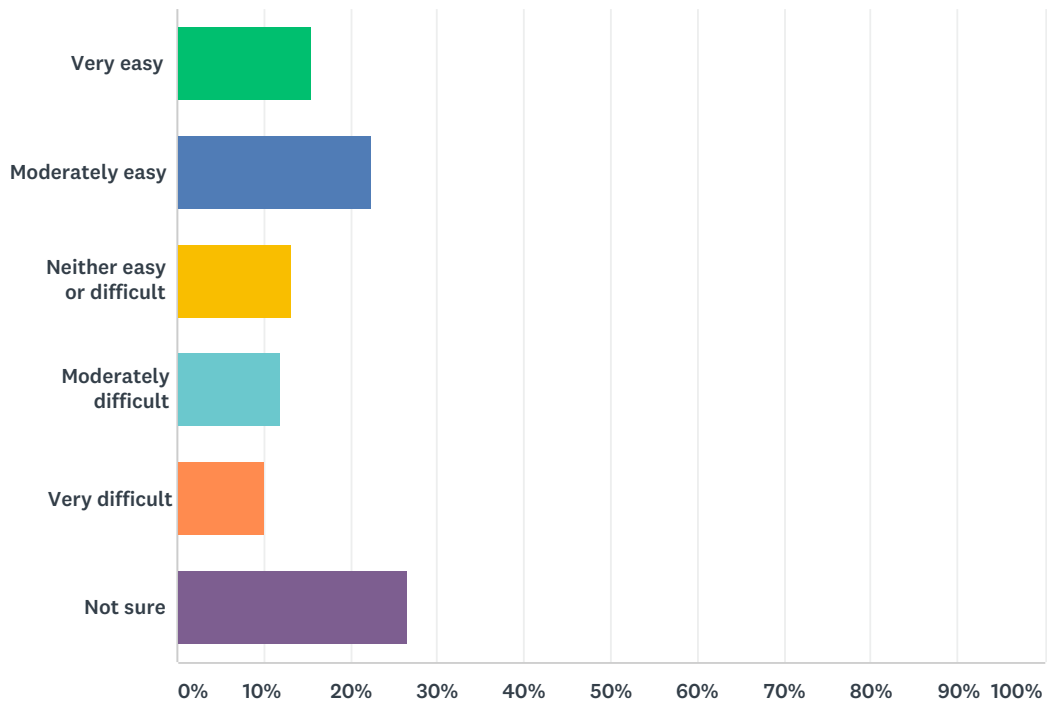

Q4 How easy is it for youth to obtain prescription drugs without a prescription in your community?

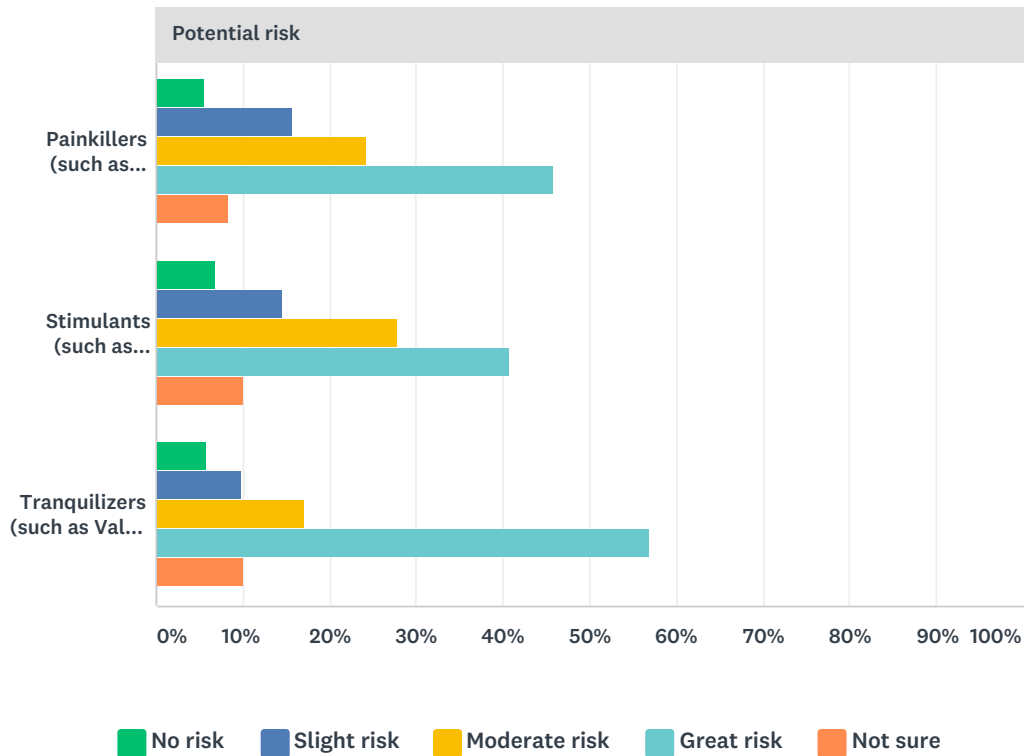

Q5 How much do you think people risk harming themselves, physically or in other ways, when they misuse prescription drugs?

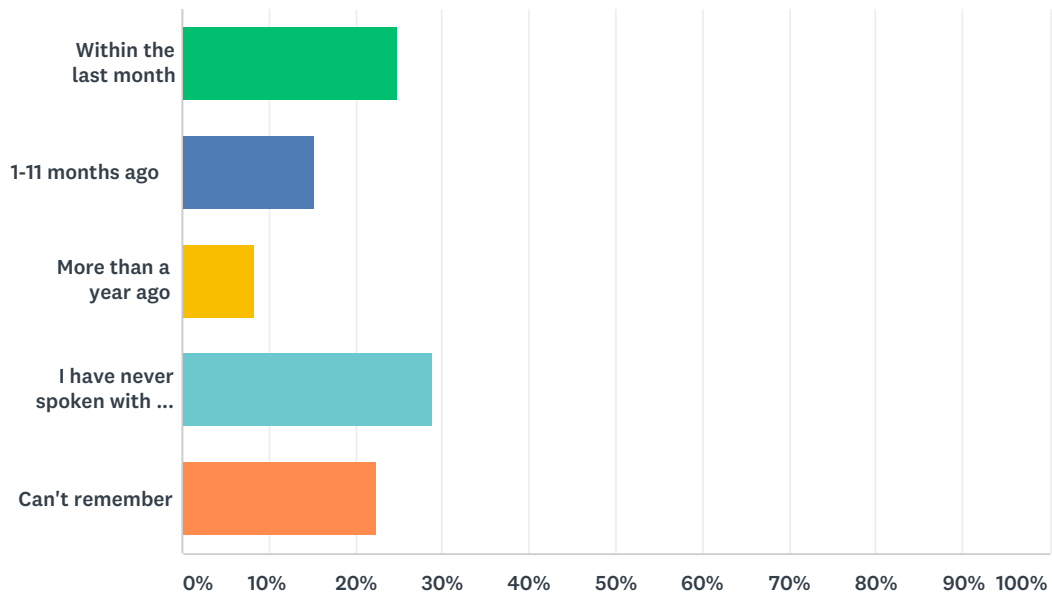

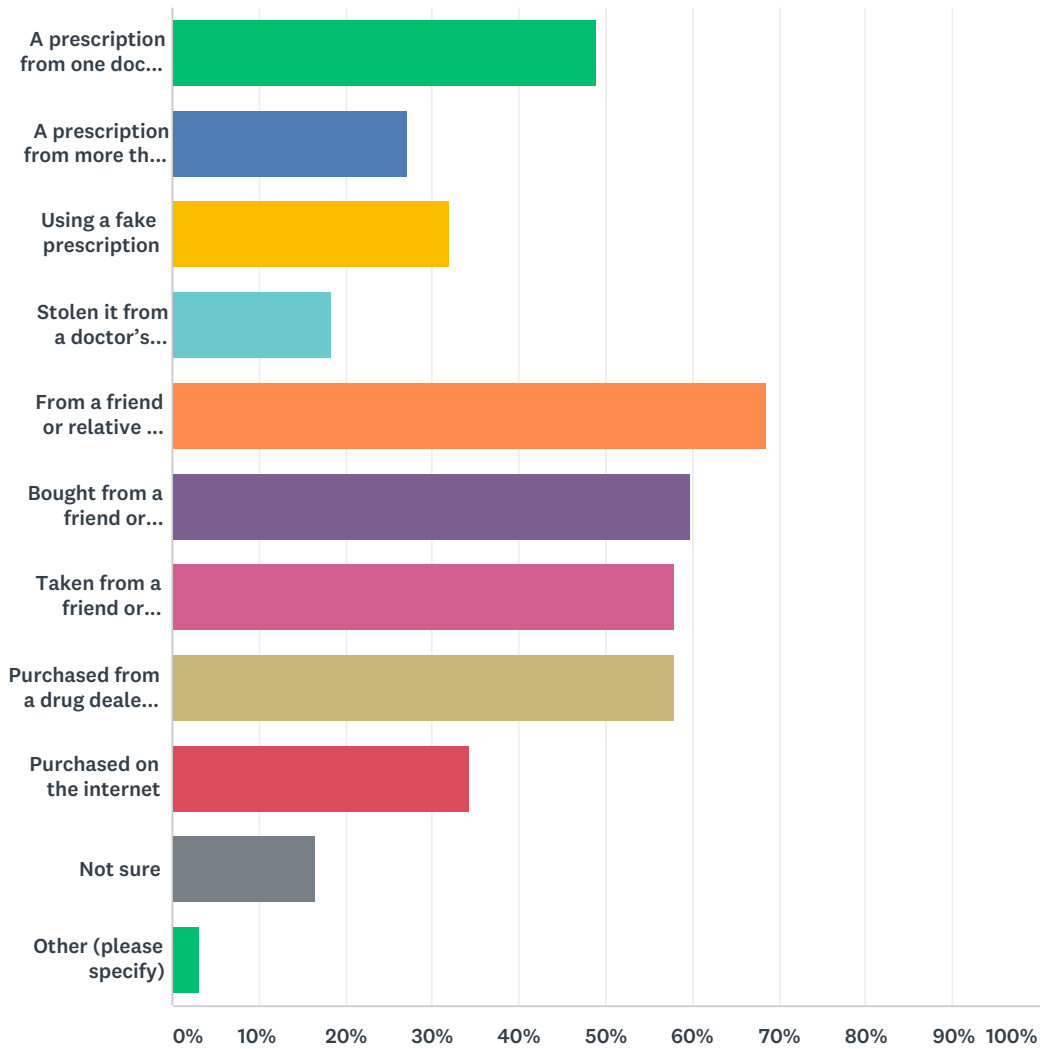

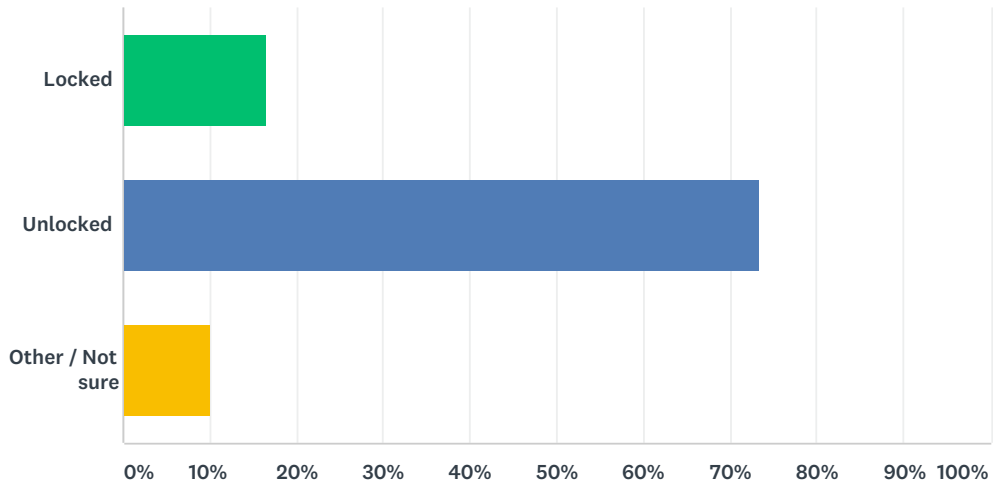

Q8 How does your family typically store prescription drugs?

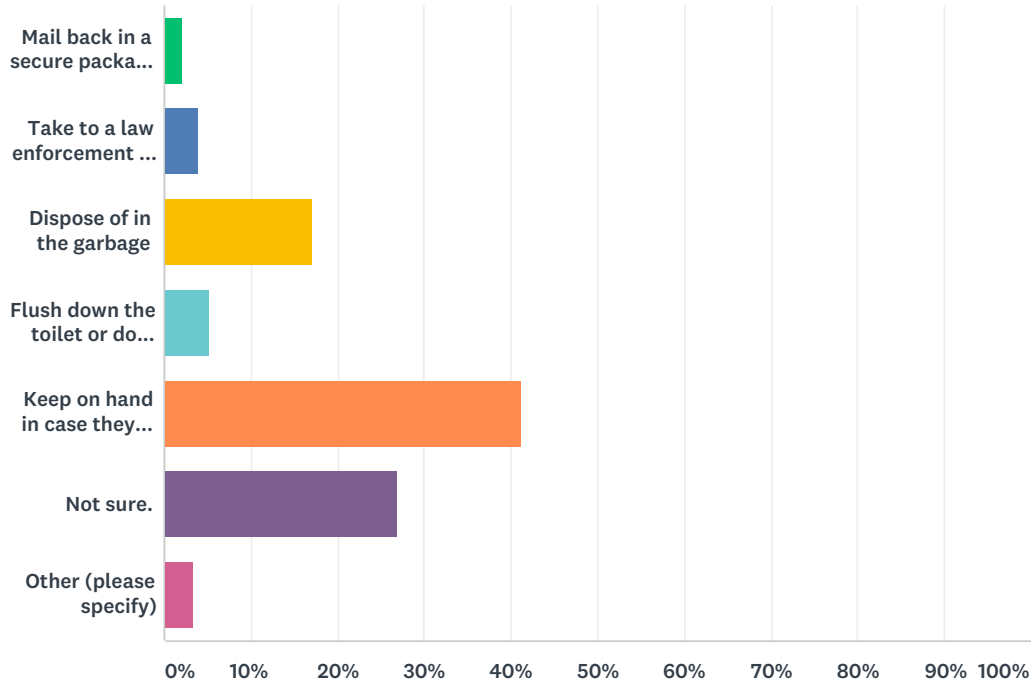

Q9 What does your family typically do with unused prescription drugs?

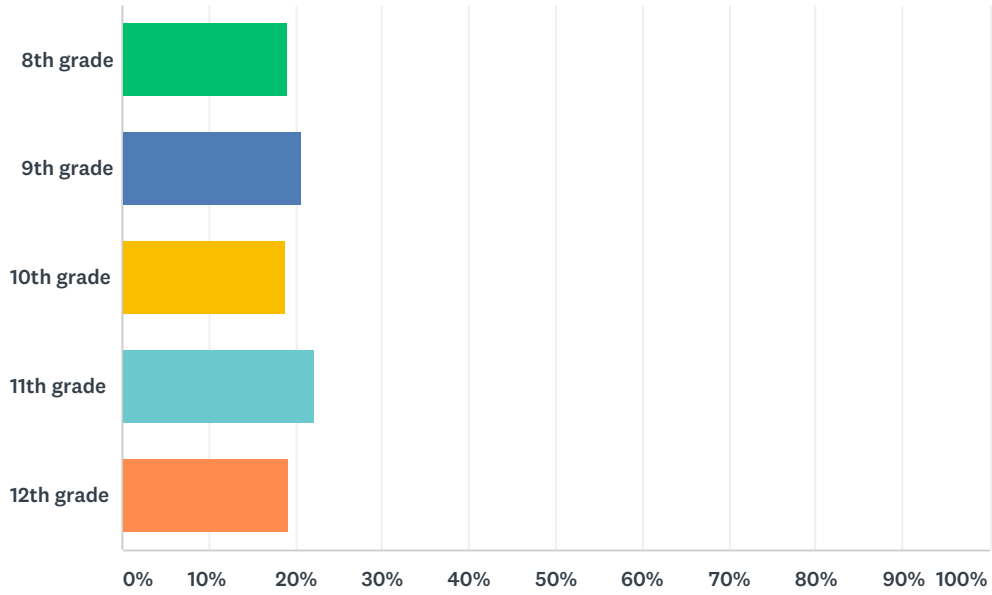

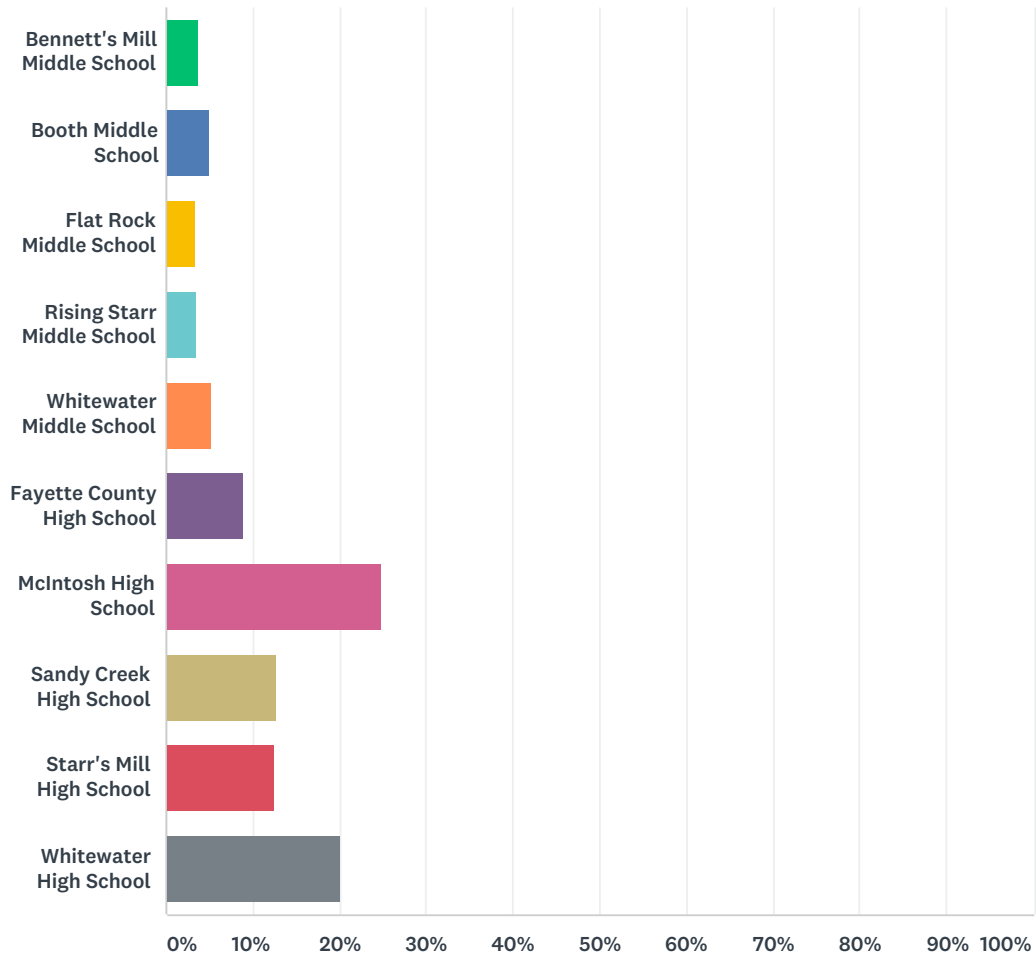
