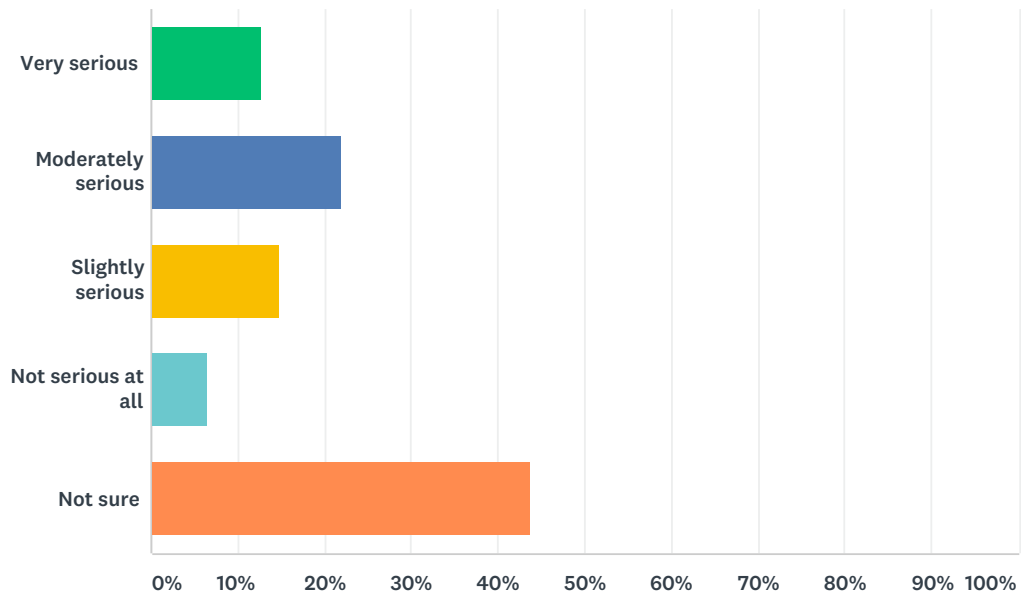


## Q1 How serious of a problem is misuse of prescription drugs in your community?

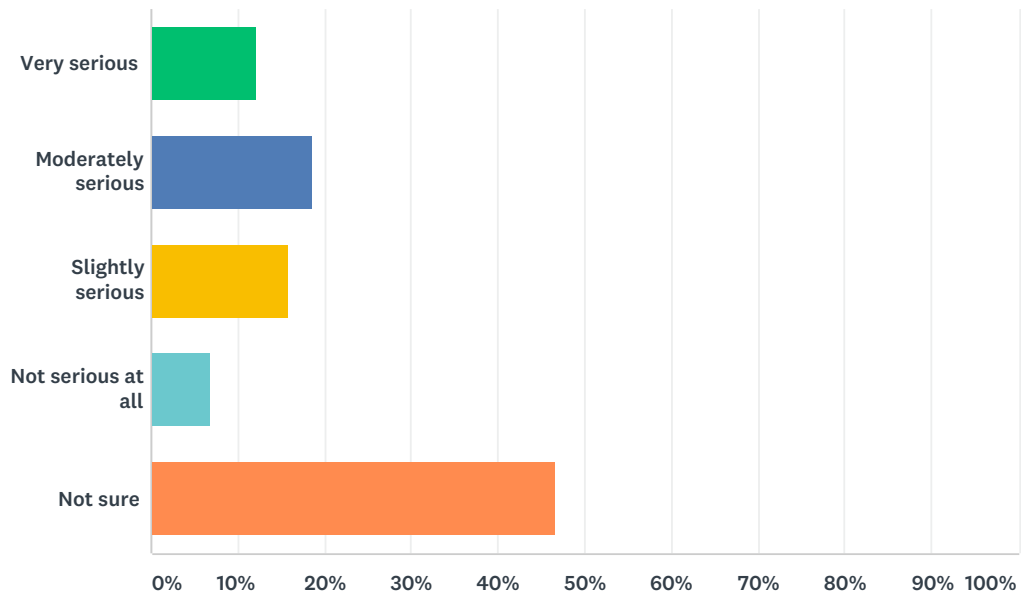

## Q2 How serious of a problem is misuse of prescription drugs by youth 18 or younger in your community?

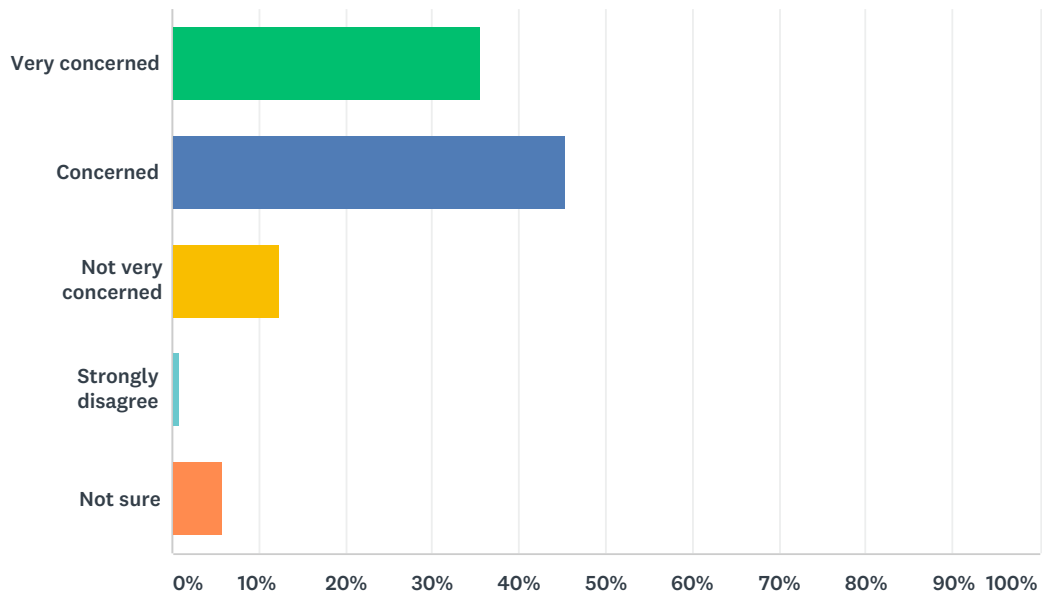

### Q3 How concerned are you that misuse of prescription drugs could be, or could become, a growing problem in your community?

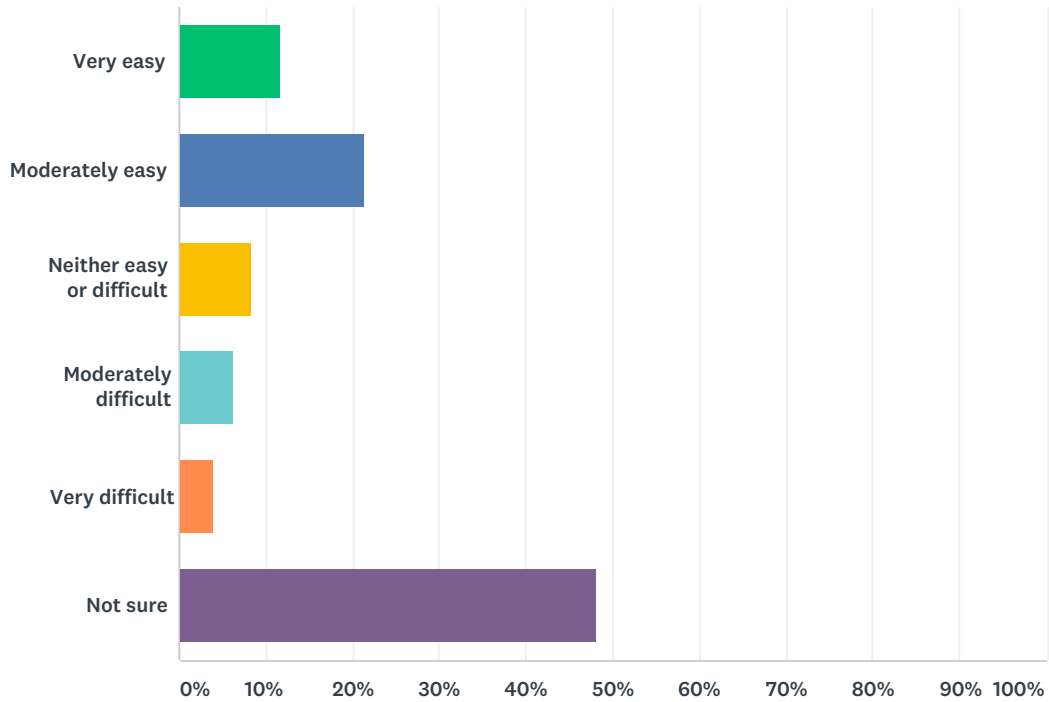

## Q4 How easy is it for youth to obtain prescription drugs without a prescription in your community?

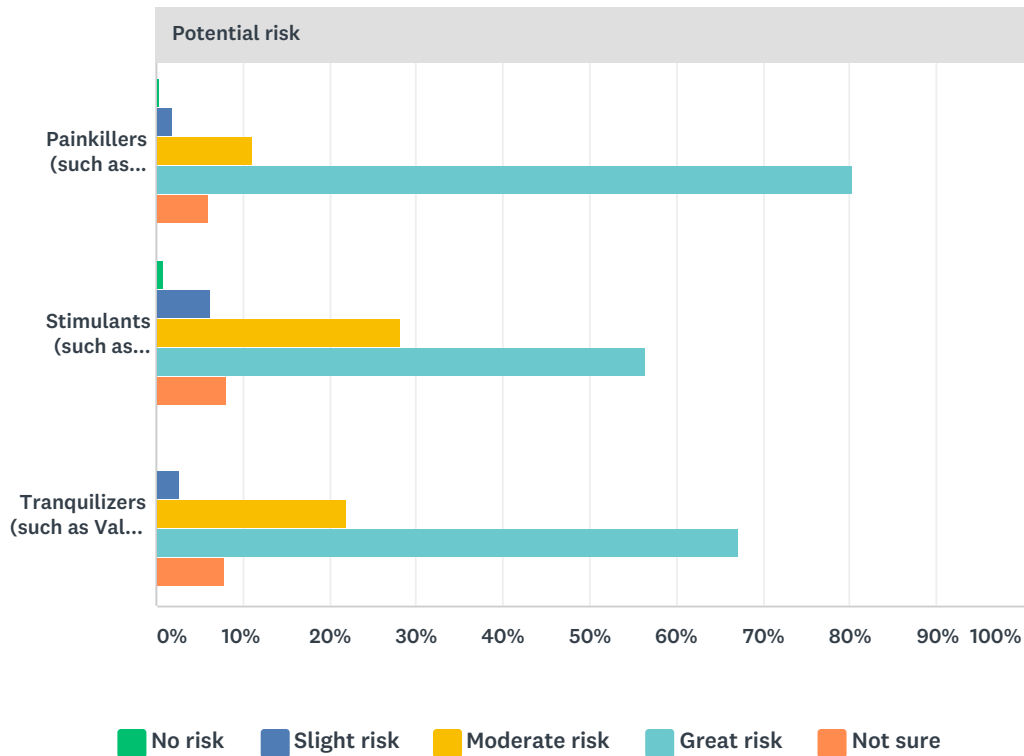

## Q5 How much do you think people risk harming themselves, physically or in other ways, when they misuse prescription drugs?

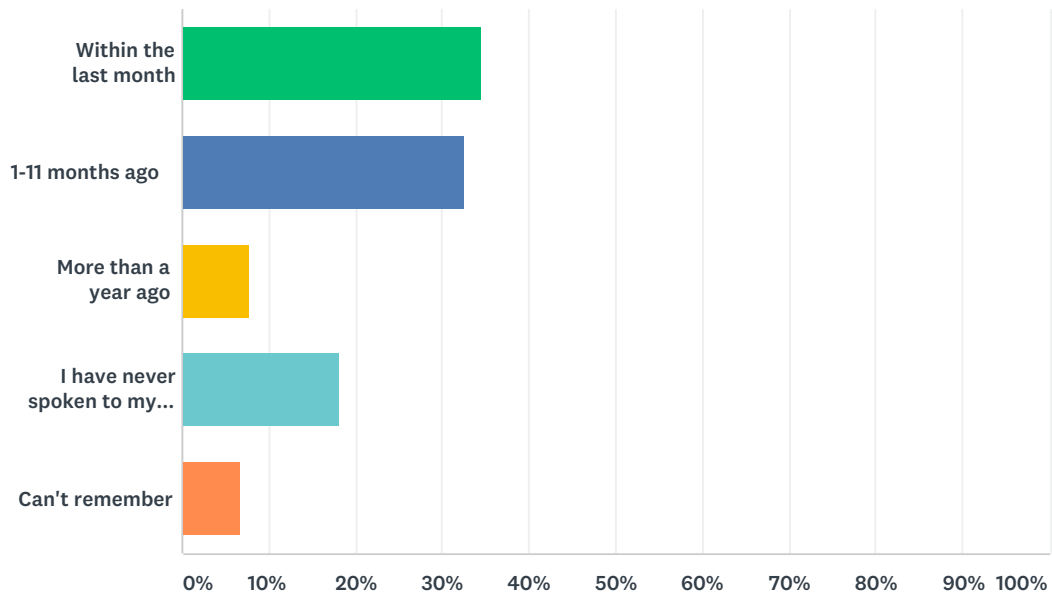

## Q6 When was the last time you talked with your teen about the possibilities and/or risks of prescription drug misuse?

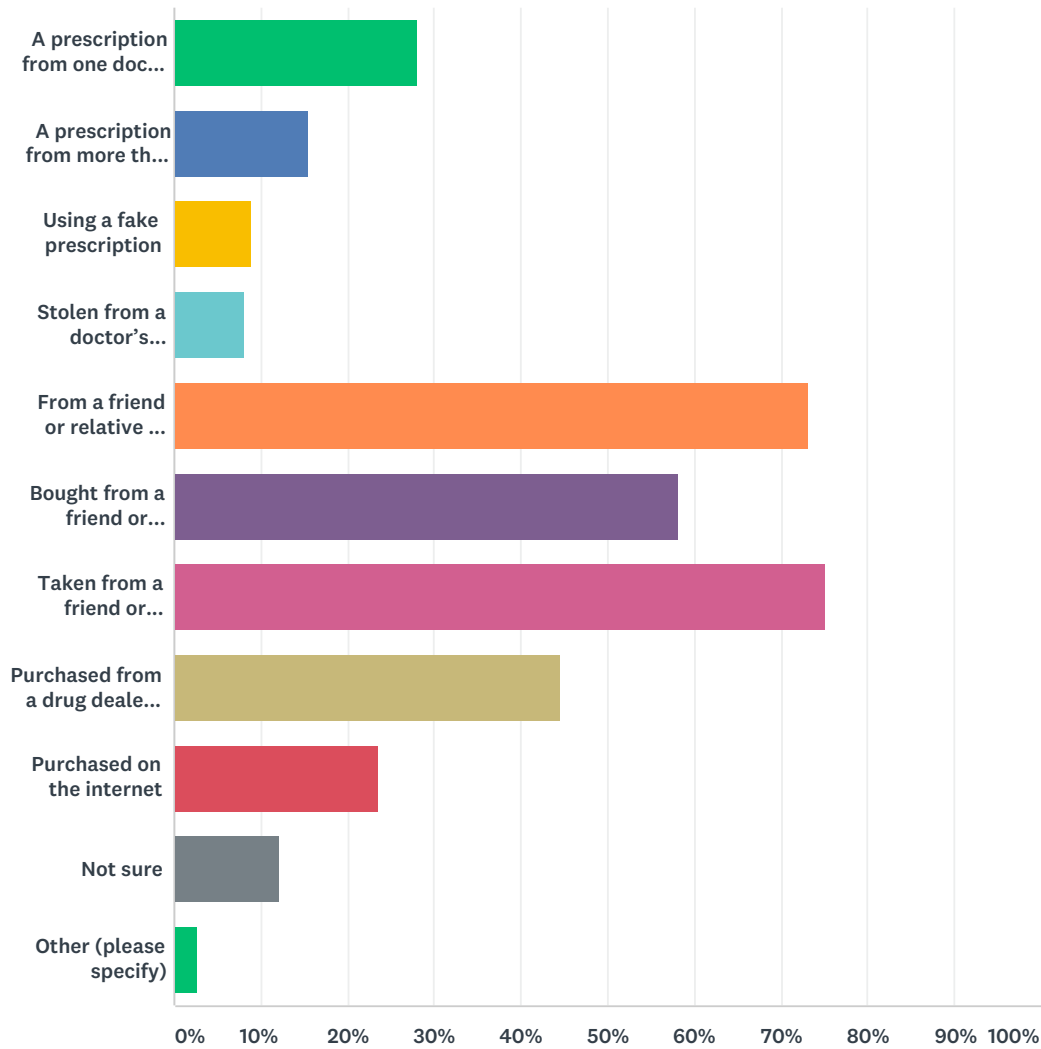

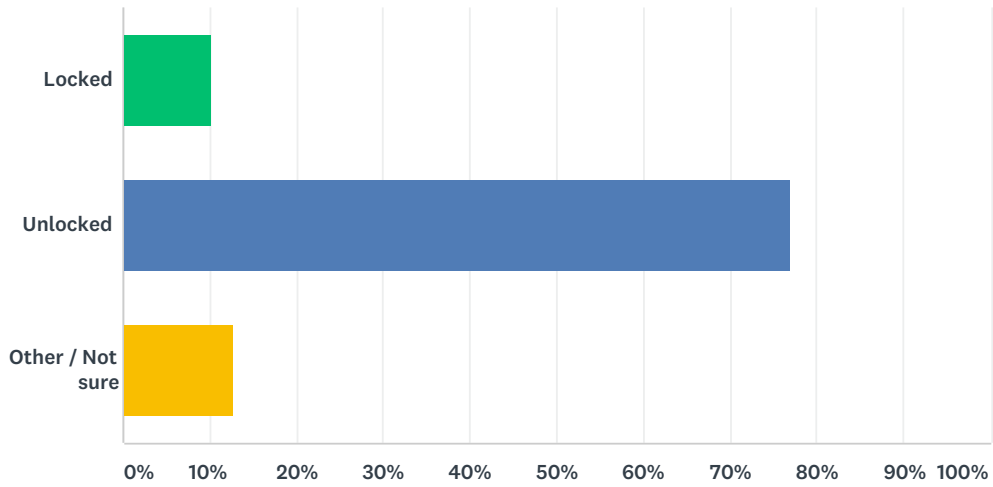

## Q8 How does your family typically store prescription drugs?

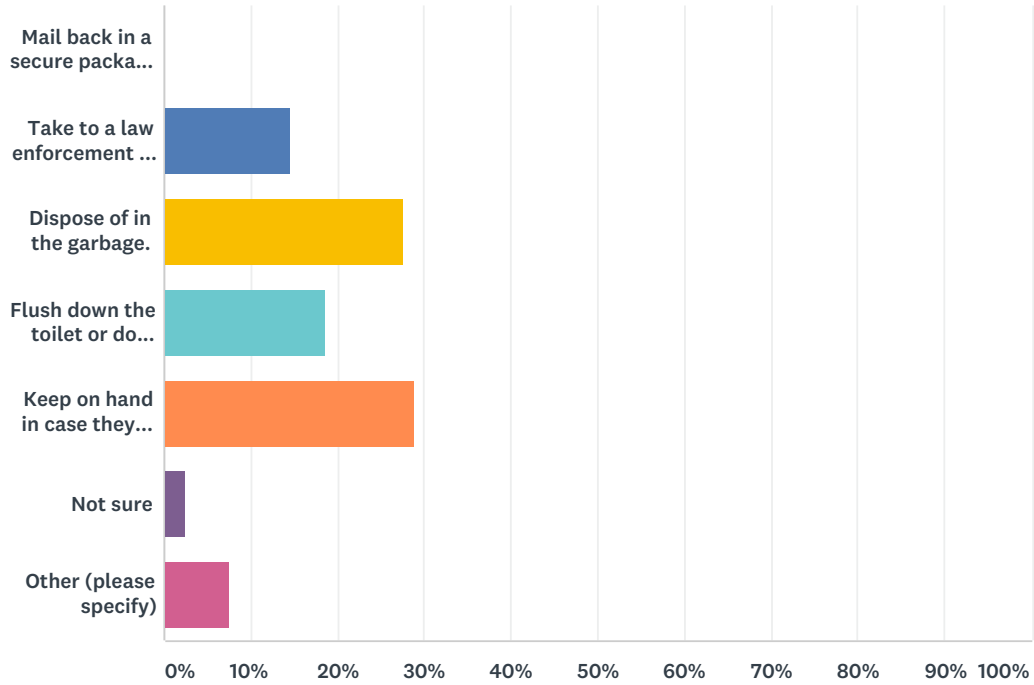

## Q9 What does your family typically do with unused prescription drugs?

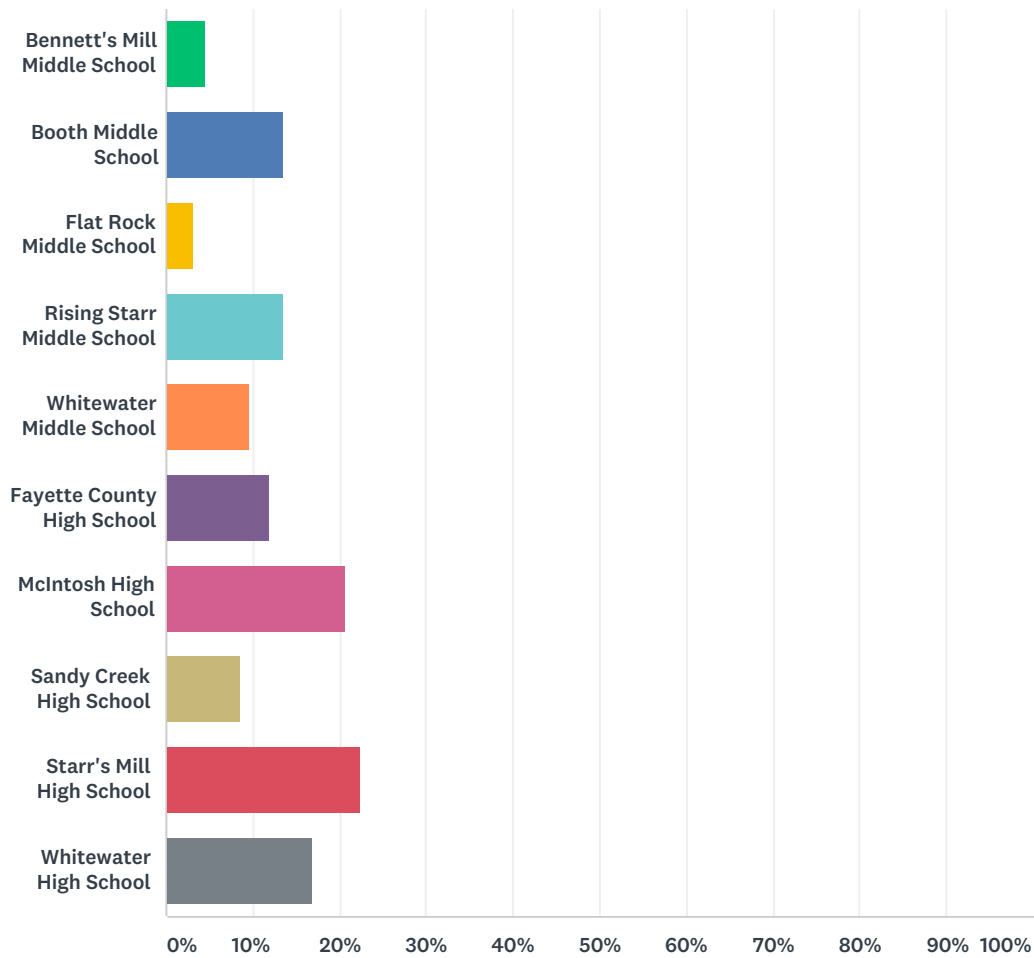
